| 1890 | Blackfella Creek | 25 | Ngarinman, Bilinara | Pastoralists | Reprisal | | |
| 1892 | 1 st Massacre Willaroo Station | 30 | Warlpiri | Colonisers / Stockmen, drovers | A double massacre in a reprisal for looting Willaroo Station and the killing of the Willaroo manager Syd Scott | | |
| 1892 | 2 nd Massacre Willaroo Station | 30 | Wardaman | Mounted Police, stockmen, drovers | Reprisal | | |
| 1893 | Collins Creek | 53 | Ngarinyman, Bilinara | Colonisers | Reprisal for the spearing of Constable Collins | | |
| 1894 | Victoria River | 10 men, women & children | Ngarinyman, Karrangpurru, Nungali, Malngin, Wardaman, Ngaliwurru, Bilinara | Police operation reprisal led by Constable Willshire | Reprisal | | |
| 1894 | Wickham River | 35 men | Ngarinyman, Bilinara | Colonisers | Reprisal | | |

| 1894- 1895 | Gordon Creek & VRD | 60 | Bilinara, Wardaman | Mounted Constable E O'Keefe, Jack Watson and colonisers | Police sanctioned massacres |

| 1895 | Little Gregory Creek | 10 | Ngarinyman, Karrangpurru, Nungali, Malngin, Wardaman, Ngaliwurru, Bilinara | Colonisers | Reprisal for attack on Paddy Cahill |
| 1895 | Blackfellows Knob | 15 | Ngarinyman, Bilinara | Police, pastoralists | These are known as the "killing times" |
| 1886 | Seale Gorge | 30 men, women & children | Ngarinyman, Bilinara | Stockmen & drovers | After the massacre the bodies were dragged to a pyre and burnt. |
| 1886 | Bradshaw Station | 15 | Ngarinyman, Bilinara | Pastoralists | Dispersal operation. Part of a group of massacres |
| 1896- 1897 | Waterloo Station | 100 | Ngarinyman | Mounted police & pastoralists | Massacre after the spearing of "Big Johnny Durack". Part of a group of massacres |
| 1905 | Delamere Station | 15 | Wardaman | Colonisers / Pastoralists | Unknown |
| 1910 | Humbert River Station | 30 | Ngarinyman, Karrangpurru, Nungali, Malngin, Wardaman, Ngaliwurru, Bilinara | Colonisers | Reprisal for murder of "Brigalow Bill" |
| 1911- 1914 | Bull's Head Pocket | 30 | Ngarinyman, Bilinara | Pastoralists | The killing occurred during a corroborree |
| 1911- 1914 | Kidman Knob | 30 | Ngarinyman, Bilinara | Pastoralists | People were engaged in ceremony |
| 1918 | Auvergne Station | 7 | Wardaman, Bilinara, Mudburra | Station employees | Reprisal for the spearing of station employee Alexander MacDonald |
| 1920 | Coomanderoo Station | 30 | Manngayarr | Colonisers | Killing in reprisal for a milking cow being killed |
| 1920 | Wattie Creek | 8 women | Gurindji | Colonisers/stockmen | A group of women refused to submit to gang rape and were shot." |
| 1920- 1922 | Wave Hill Station | 30 | Gurindji | Stockmen | Paddy Cahill's assistance was called 'in about 1924 to |
